
STUDENTS NOTICE FOR - II, III, IV B H M S

The SOP for Students regarding physical re-opening of College.

1. Self-discipline is most important to contain the spread of COVID-19 pandemic through social distancing and maintaining hygienic condition.
2. All students must wear mouth and nose covering masks and take all preventive measures.
3. Every student must carry their own sanitizer, soap, mask, drinking water.
4. Students must carry own Id card.
5. Must install 'Aarogya Setu App' in their mobile.
6. It is important for the students to be physically and mentally fit to handle any requirements.
7. The students must inculcate activities that will increase immunity-boosting mechanism which may include exercise, yoga, eating fresh fruits and healthy food (avoid fast food), sleep timely.
8. Give moral support to your friends under stress due to COVID-19 pandemic.
9. Students should follow the guidelines, advisories and instructions issued by the University and College regarding health and safety measures in view of COVID-19 pandemic.
10. If a student has come in close contact with Covid-19 patient during last 7 days before reaching to the college, and if he/she develops symptom, should get him/her tested and inform accordingly with sending report of RT-PCR. Only after testing negative, should join college with prior information and permission of HOL.
11. Self-monitoring of Health and reporting of if any illness immediately.
12. Sanitization of classroom and premises before and after classes will be done regularly by Institute.
13. Screening (Thermal checkup, SpO2 (SOS)) at entries will be done daily.
14. Symptomatic students will be reported and taken care of BVMF's Bharati Hospital in the same campus.
15. Counselling for anxiety, stress about Covid 19 pandemic as well as Post Covid care will be taken at Post Covid Management Center of Homoeopathic Hospital by College.
